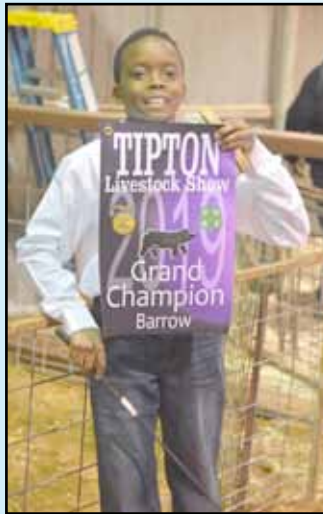

She has three children and eight grandchildren. Today, she is sharing her recipe for Runza Casserole. Sounds delicious!

Runza Casserole

2 LB. HAMBURGER
2 FINELY CHOPPED ONIONS
4 CUPS FRESH CHOPPED CABBAGE
SALT AND PEPPER TO TASTE
2 PKG REFRIGERATED CRESCENT ROLLS
1 LB. SHREDDED MOZZARELLA CHEESE

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Spread one tube of crescent rolls into the bottom of a 9X13 pan and bake 7 minutes or until brown.

While that is in the oven, brown the hamburger and add the cabbage. Let it steam for a few minutes. Add the salt and pepper. Spread the hamburger/cabbage mix into the pan on top of the baked crescent dough. Sprinkle the cheese on top of the meat mixture.

Spread the 2nd tube of crescent rolls over the top of the cheese. Bake for 35-40 minutes, covering with foil the last 10 minutes to soften the crust.
