Blessings Received

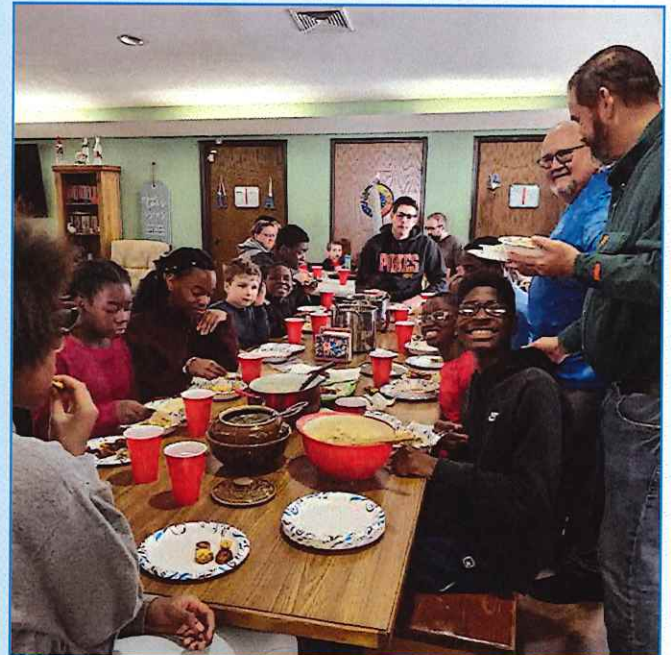

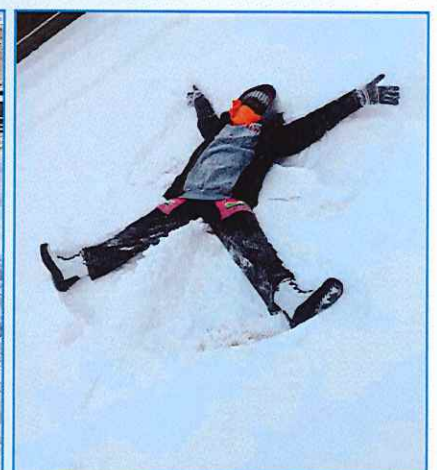
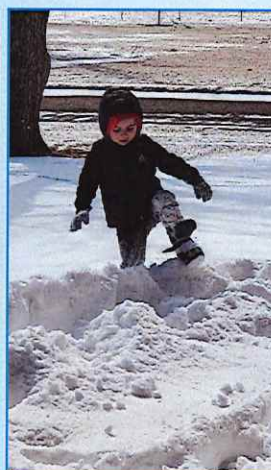
The African food, as they call it, is very spicy and the ingredients are unique. They have prepared pepper soup, which as the name implies is spicy. They also enjoy chicken feet.

Mix it. Then it can simmer for half an hour, while you apply your nail polish and find the car keys. That night reheat it for 10 minutes. It's good!

Ann Landers Meatloaf

2 pounds ground round steak
2 eggs
1 1/2 cup bread crumbs
3/4 cup catsup
1 t. Accent
1/2 cup warm water
1 Pkg. Lipton's Onion Soup Mix

Mix thoroughly. Put into loaf pan, cover with 3 strips of bacon if you like that flavor. Pour over all one 8 ounce can Hunt's tomato sauce. Bake one hour at 350 degrees. Serves 6.
